



# Patchwork Placemats Tutorial

for Art Gallery Fabrics*

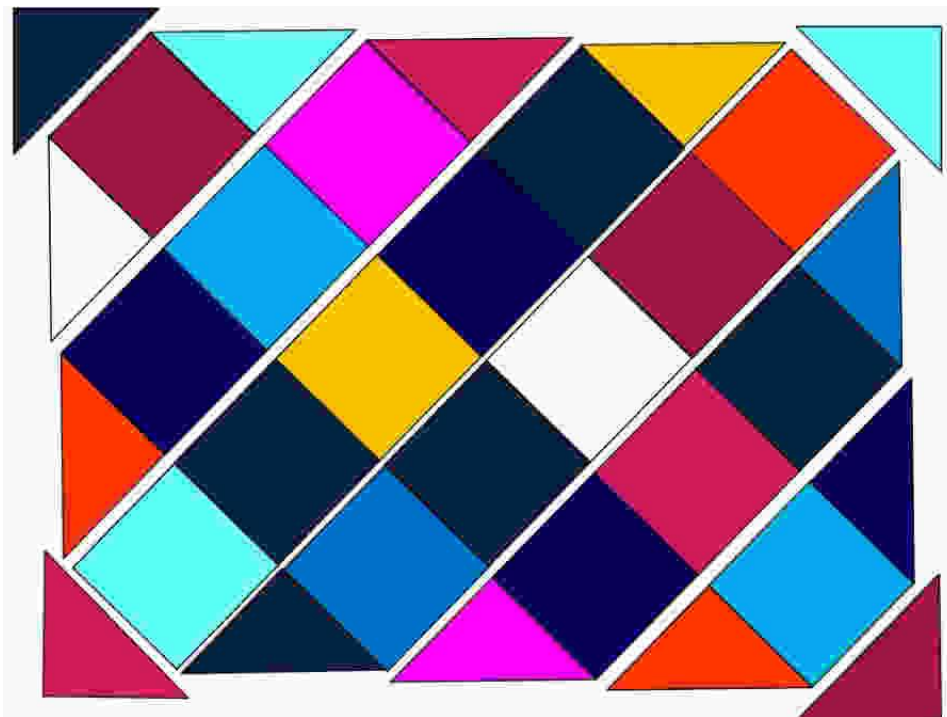


Earlier this month I had the opportunity to participate in making some things for the newest [Mediterraneo](#) fabric line by [Katarina Roccella](#) for [Art Gallery Fabrics](#). Yesterday I shared tutorials for the potholders I made. Today, I have a tutorial for some placemats. I love how the colors and how they turned out!

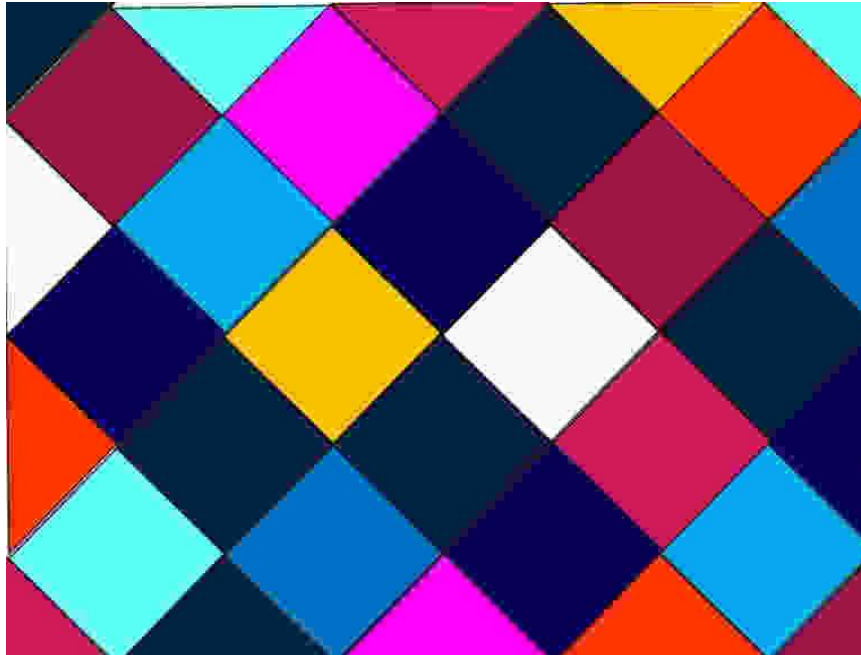
For each placemat, you will need:

- (25) assorted 4 inch squares
- (1) 15.5 inch x 20.5 inch batting
- (1) 16 inch x 21 inch backing fabric
- 1/8 yard binding fabric

Arrange squares in desired layout, cutting 7 of the squares in half as shown below. Begin stitching into diagonal rows.



Sew the rows together. Press seams and then trim to measure 15 inches by 20 inches.



Make your quilt sandwich by placing your backing fabric right side down. Place batting on top of that and then finally the front fabric face up. [Baste](#) and then quilt as desired. Trim to 9" square and [bind](#) to finish off.
